ORAL ORDER

NOTICE, returnable on 1.11.2017.

Interim Relief in terms of paragraph 13(E) is granted but with condition that petitioner shall file an undertaking before this Court that in case they could not succeed in the petition or in case the fee structure is modified in appropriate proceedings reducing it to less than Rs.3,50,000/-, then, in both such cases,

petitioner shall refund the difference of fees between Rs.3,50,000/- and fees that may be decided hereinafter to all the students who has paid such fee after this order. For the purpose, petitioner has to disclose such fact to all the students on the Website and also on Notice Board of the College and shall also convey all the students whenever they deposit fee. It is further directed that considering the difference between the provisional fees claimed by the petitioner and fees approved by the Fee Regulatory Committee being Rs.2,00,000/-, petitioner has to keep a separate account wherein Rs.1,00,000/- in respect of each students admitted for the Course of MBA is to be deposited and such account shall be kept with such amount as it is till disposal of this petition.

Direct Service is permitted.
